

THE 7 LAWS OF THE UNIVERSE

There are seven Universal laws or Natural Laws that govern all the processes of creation,

Management and evolution of the Universe. Of the seven, four are fundamental: they govern and control the processes of development and evolution of consciousness within the human species, anywhere in the universe. These four Laws constitute the lower triangle, also called the “triangle of hell”, which constitutes the lower part of the Universal Laws.

- **What are the 7 natural law theory?**
- Natural Law Theory proposes that as physical laws of nature exist, so do universal moral laws. These laws disclose themselves to us upon close examination of the world and the nature of humans. Aspects of natural law theory date back to Plato, who posited the existence of transcendental “Forms” (Plato, 1992).

Are there 7 or 12 universal laws?

The planes of existence you know most well operate by these Universal Laws. They are the physical, mental, emotional and spiritual planes, respectively. There are 7 Universal Laws of Principles defined in the book, The Kybalion. There are 5 additional Universal Laws, which fall under the first 7.

The four specific Laws which govern the human experience

- Nature
- Harmony
- Correspondence
- Evolution

Nature

The Law of natural selection. It enables balance between everything that exists. Everything outside perfection will be destroyed. There is no compassion, forgiveness or feelings.

Harmony

Feelings appear and seek balance between the force of nature. This can be represented by scales. It has to do with the Law of cause and Effect (action and reaction). It is the Law of Education of the Universe.

Correspondence

It leads us to accepting that every process has a perfect objective. If we find a block this means that we are violating it. We produce every circumstance ourselves. Nobody is to blame.

Evolution

The law of learning, Law of Internal Change or Transformation. Nobody is harmful or beneficial to us. It takes us from confrontation with life to the ability to make the most (value and enjoy) of what life teaches us.
